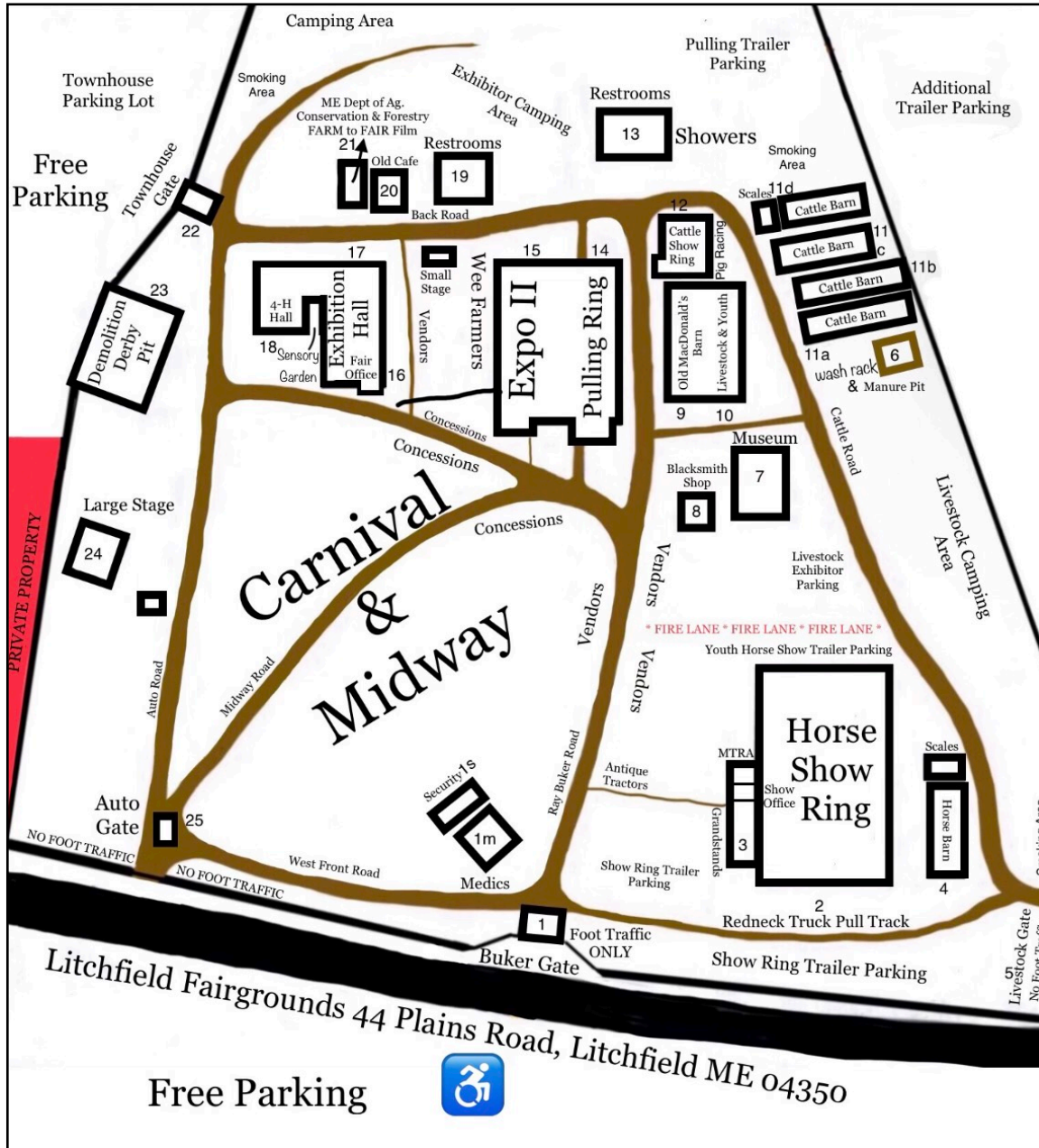


Map of the Litchfield Fairgrounds
